- Take and record readings from instruments;
- Analyze instrument readings and make necessary adjustments to equipment;
- Adjust treatment equipment to maintain steady operation;
- Complete tests to determine appropriate chemical dosing rates;
- Prepare reports and maintain operating logs;
- Respond to complaints from the public and inquiries from management;
- Work with Districts and Boards
- Basic maintenance of the equipment; and
- Troubleshoot water or wastewater treatment systems and its processes.
